
APPROVE: Banning Loadout is granted an approval for amendment ACT/007/034-96A effective November 22, 1996.




The enclosed amendment is being submitted as remedial action for NOV96-39-5-1 issued on November 18, 1996. This amendment corrects locations and further delineates runoff control structures at the Banning Loadout. In addition, for purposes of convenience, a noncoal waste area has been added east of #1 conveyor. Also, the reclaim and escape tunnels have been added and the non-freezing agent storage tank, near the silo, has been removed.

With respect to the specific nature of violation NOV96-39-5-1, all water diversions and treatments have been shown on the enclosed maps, Exhibit 7-1 (revised 11/19/96) or Exhibit 7-1a (new submittal). Exhibit 7-1 has been revised by adding a line symbol to delineate the berms and a crosshatch symbol to delineate the embankment areas. A new map, Exhibit 7-1a, is included to show sediment control structures along portions of the access road which are within the permit area.

Please replace Exhibit 7-1 with the enclosed Exhibit 7-1 (revised 11/19/96) and add Exhibit 7-1a in the current Banning Loadout permit. Five copies of each exhibit have been included herein.




