1. PERMIT -

The Mining and Reclamation Permit was renewed on 12/20/94. It will expire on 10/25/98.

The coal sampled on 11/17/97 was required by the Mining and Reclamation Permit.

There are no outstanding minor amendments at the Division.

4a. DIVERSIONS -

The diversions were spot checked and comply with the R645 Coal Rules. The diversions by the coal loadout facility had been recently cleaned and graded.

No water was flowing through the diversions.

4b. SEDIMENT POND -

The sediment pond was inspected for third quarter on 9/12/97. There were no reports of hazardous conditions. The pond is an incised pond.

The pond contained a small amount of water. It did not discharge water this year.

4c. OTHER SEDIMENT CONTROL AREAS -

The silt fences were cleaned out recently and comply with the Coal Rules. These fences are located along the coal haul road.

13. REVEGETATION -

The permittee and Division's Soil Specialist reviewed the vegetation test plots as required in the MRP.


21. BONDING -
