In Appendix A of the annual report received by the Division, the Permittee provides the quarterly impoundment inspection reports. The first quarter 2017 report indicates that the sediment level in the Banning Loadout Sediment Pond is 0.4' below the 60% cleanout elevation (5,486.2' and 5,486.6' respectively). The second, third and fourth quarter reports indicated that the sediment level was 0.36' below the 60% cleanout elevation.

The Permittee should plan on cleaning out the Banning Loadout Sediment Pond in 2018.
