RE: Permit Transfer Information Deficiencies (UMC 788.18),
Sunnyside Fuels Corporation, Kaiser Coal Corporation,
Sunnyside Mine, ACT/007/007, Folder #2, Carbon County, Utah

Sunnyside Fuels Corporation submitted a draft permit application on September 7, 1988. I have the following comments about the permit transfer information:

- UMC 788.18(a)(1)(iii) Reclamation bond must be posted before permit can be transferred.
- UMC 788.18(a)(2)(iii)
- UMC 782.13(a)(1) Permit applicant's phone number must be included in the PAP.
- UMC 782.13(a)(5) The operator in this case is the new operator, if applicable (not the operator identified in the Operating Agreement, Kaiser Coal). Please correct in the PAP.
- UMC 782.13(e) The correct address of BLM (surface owner) must be included in the submittal.
- UMC 782.17 The length of Permit Term was not addressed. Please address for inclusion in the PAP.
- UMC 782.18 The Certificate of Insurance was not found (Figure II-1). Please submit for inclusion in the PAP.

The application for the UPDES permit was filed with the Utah Bureau of Water Pollution Control and the EPA on August 1, 1988. No other permits were listed.

The applicant is required to have an approved Air Quality Protection Plan, a Spill Prevention Control and Counter Measurement Plan, and a Fire Extinguishing Plan (MSHA). Applications for these permits must be submitted and approvals obtained from the appropriate agencies.

A copy of the applications for inclusion in the PAP is satisfactory until the approvals are obtained.

All of the above-mentioned deficiency items must be addressed before the permit can be transferred.
