Kaiser Coal Corporation, Sunnyside Mines, is the owner of Utah Mining and Reclamation Permit No. ACT/007/007. This permit is for 14,475 acres of land, some of which are undisturbed by mining. Within the permit area, Kaiser has leased 72.5 acres of surface to Sunnyside Power Corporation. Sunnyside Power plans to use this area to site an electrical power generation facility.

This letter is to request a change to Kaiser's Mining and Reclamation Permit to remove from the permit the 72.5 acres leased by Sunnyside Power. Attached drawing no. A4-0207 indicates the location of the subject lands.






