Dear Randy,

This letter is in regards to Violation Nos. N93-13-1-1, N93-32-5-2 No. 1 of 2 and N93-32-5-2 No. 2 of 2.

**Violation No. N93-13-1-1:** For failure to identify and describe all mining and related activities with the permit area. This violation was issued specifically for the crusher facility located on the power plant site. The Division requested that this facility be incorporated into the permit site and included in the PAP. During this time Callister, Duncan and Nebeker (CDN) will be preparing a Brief and Appeal for this violation. CDN requires this time to perform adequate legal research into the laws, rules, and regulations concerning this violation. SCA is requesting that this violation be extended to December 15, 1993.

**Violation No. N93-32-5-2 No. 1 of 2:** For failure to place, in a controlled manner, and/or treat acid-forming material. Failure to place coal mine waste in an approved disposal facility. This violation was issued specifically for removal of the acid-forming material on the Old Coarse Refuse Road. At this time, SCA has begun removing this material with the services of a local contractor. Due to the extreme nature of this violation in terms of time to complete and equipment needed, there has not been adequate resources available to satisfy the requirements of this violation. Therefore, in response to this violation, SCA commits to having a detailed ammendment including plans and permit changes submitted to DOGM by December 15, 1993.

**Violation No. N93-32-5-2 No. 2 of 2:** For failure to maintain diversion structures. This violation was issued specifically for the coarse refuse pile diversion. Currently, the third lift of the coarse refuse lifts is being covered with 2 feet of borrow material according to the approved plan submitted by SCA. The 100yr 6hr diversion from the coarse refuse lifts can not be maintained until the third lift is completely covered. The covering of the third lift should be complete by December 3, 1993 and the diversion will be maintained at that time. Therefore, SCA is requesting an extension to December 15, 1993 to fulfill the requirements of this violation.
