Dear Ms. Boyd:

Reference is made to your letter dated October 6, 1993, regarding the Sunnyside Cogeneration Coarse Refuse Pile Operations located in Section 7, Township 15 South, Range 14 East, southeast of East Carbon City, Carbon County, Utah. The purpose of the letter was to describe the cessation of a slurry cell within the project boundaries.

Your project has been reviewed in accordance with Section 404 of the Clean Water Act under which the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers regulates the discharge of dredged and fill material into waters of the United States including wetlands. Based on the information provided it appears the project will not involve such discharges, as no discharge is being proposed. Therefore, a Department of the Army permit will not be required for the above-mentioned work.
