Dear Randy,

This letter is in regards to Violation No. N93-40-6-4, 4 of 4. The violation was issued, "For transporting and stockpiling of coal and/or coal refuse to the Coarse Refuse Pile (from an unpermitted site) in a manner that is not approved under the current PAP." The violation applies to the haul road from the permit boundary (adjacent to the cogen plant) to the Coarse Refuse Pile and the areas of the Coarse Refuse Pile and West Slurry Cell where reject coal and/or coal refuse from the cogen facility has been placed.

In order to satisfy the requirements of this violation, SCA is required to immediately cease transporting and stockpiling the material as noted above. All material that was improperly transported and stockpiled must be removed from the areas noted above and moved back to the cogen facility. This action must be completed by October 15, 1993.

SCA is formally requesting an extension to remove this material until November 5, 1993. Weather conditions have not been conducive to performing immediate removal of the material as required in the NOV. SCA feels that it will take at least an additional three weeks to coordinate this work effort with Savage Industries. In addition, Savage's original contract obligations do not include the removal of this material, therefore, contract negotiations are required in order for Savage to proceed with this additional work.
