We are continuing to evaluate treatment processes for the Course Refuse Pile Seep on the Sunnyside Co-Generation site.

We sent a water sample today to Neutron Labs in Dickerson, Maryland for testing to determine the effectiveness of gel log dissolution to aid settling of solids. We expect results back within two weeks.

Hugh Plant has spoken with Mr. J. Scott Roberts with the Bureau of Mining and Reclamation in Pennsylvania. He is sending us information on treatment strategies currently being employed for similar situations.

I will phone you next week to arrange a time to meet with you, Ken Wyatt and Henry Sauer to discuss the Neutron Labs test results, information received from Mr. Roberts and the current status of our concept for a treatment strategy for the seep.
