

As stated in your letter, the designs and cross sections for the Pasture Pond relative to the temporary coarse refuse storage areas amendment were submitted August 6, 1993. Ms. Jessica Smith came to the Division on that date and was shown some of the major technical errors that are on the sediment pond maps that inhibit the technical review of stipulation #15. A deficiency letter is forthcoming.

A meeting has been arranged for August 11, 1993 with Ms. Jessica Smith at the Division to outline major errors in Stipulations #11, and #14, as well as outstanding deficiencies in the temporary waste storage amendment.
