RE: Course Refuse Lifts, Sunnyside Cogeneration Associates, Sunnyside Coarse Refuse and Slurry, ACT/007/035, Folder #5, Carbon County, Utah

A field visit was made on February 2, 1994 to the coarse refuse lift three area. The area had been covered with a soil material by use of a tracked loader. The majority of the surface of the soil material was determined to not be frozen and thus suitable for seeding. The tracked loader had left the soil material ridged in a vertical condition which provides for no water holding pocket for plants and a vertical conveyance system for water.

I telephoned Jim Comas, operators representative, February 3, 1994. I told him that the site was ready to seed but that the area must be ripped or graded on the contour. Additionally, I stated that the seed did not have to be raked if the seeding was done the same day as the grading or ripping.
