Dear Daron,

This submittal, as outlined on the attached Application for Permit Change, comes as scheduled in NOV N93-13-2-1. Please grant an extension to the NOV (currently extended to January 14, 1995) which will allow time for the Division to review the permit and then for SCA to respond to the review.

This submittal includes text, figures, appendices, and / or plates supporting the following areas:

- Final Reclamation Plan (Phasing, Grading, Drainage and Hydrology, Borrow Material, Seeding, and Conceptual Final Surface)
- Updated information following completion of the field work concerning the final reclamation of the Old Coarse Refuse Road NOV N93-32-5-2-1.
- Updated information following completion of the field work concerning the Culverts on the face of the Coarse Refuse Pile NOV N94-26-4-1.
- Updated information following completion of the field work concerning the addition of the Coal Pile Sediment Pond into the Permit Area. Upgrades to the sediment pond were completed as previously submitted to bring this pond up to the standards of the permit.
- The UPDES Permit as modified by the Division of Water Quality on November 7, 1994.
- The MSHA approval of the program for Impoundment Inspections.
- Other modifications have also been included to respond to specific needs of the permit as recommended by Division Staff during their reviews.


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NOV N93-13-2-1 was written by Randy Harden, as the Permit Supervisor, to assist SCA in completing the requirements for the permit. A schedule was accepted at that time for the submission of each required part of the permit. SCA believes that this submittal should substantially complete the items required in the regulations for the permit. Only some minor background data remains to be added in the future.


