

Request for Phase I Bond Release - Old Coarse Refuse Road Area

During the Summer and Fall of 1994, Sunnyside Cogeneration Associates (SCA) completed reclamation of the Old Coarse Refuse Road which included the earthwork and seeding. This was done in accordance with the requirements for Final Reclamation identified in the SCA Permit No. ACT/007/035. The Notice of Violation N93-32-5-2, which prompted the early reclamation work, was terminated on December 13, 1994.

Now that the appropriate backfilling, regrading, drainage control and seeding has been completed for Phase I of the reclamation plan (See Chapter 10 for specific details of the plan for reclamation of the Old Coarse Refuse Road), SCA requests release of sixty percent of the bond for the applicable area in accordance with R645-301-880.310.

This reclamation earthwork was bonded to cover the 5.5 acres with four feet of borrow material (35,500 cubic yards). Releasing 60% of the earthwork bond leaves 14,200 cubic yards corresponding to the remaining 40%. At the current bond unit cost of \$1.45/ cu yd this remaining bond corresponds to \$20,590.00.

Due to the fact that the reclamation was completed and accepted in 1994, and has not been disturbed since that time, please set the ten year liability period beginning in 1994.
