

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

ACT/007/035 #2

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC NOTICE IS TO DECLARE THE STATE OF UTAH'S INTENTION TO REISSUE A GROUND WATER DISCHARGE PERMIT UNDER AUTHORITY OF THE UTAH WATER QUALITY ACT, SECTION 19-5-104(1)(i) AND R317-6 UTAH CODE ANNOTATED 1953, AS AMENDED.

Sunnyside Cogeneration Facility is a coal-fired power plant which produces approximately 51 MW net of electricity. The primary fuel stock for the plant is waste coal tailings that resulted from the operation of a large underground coal mine for nearly a century. Approximately 800 to 1000 tons per day of ash is generated by burning the waste coal. The ash is disposed of in a landfill in the NW 1/4, Sec. 12, T.15 S., R. 13 E., SLBM, approximately one mile from the power plant. This ash is excluded from the definition of solid waste and is regulated by the Division of Water Quality under a ground water discharge permit.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Public comments are invited any time prior to August 2, 1996. Comments may be directed to the Division of Water Quality, 288 North 1460 West, Salt Lake City, Utah 84114-4870. All comments received prior to August 2, 1996 will be considered in the formulation of final determinations to be imposed on the permit. A public hearing may be held if written requests are received within the first 15 days of this public comment period that demonstrate significant public interest and substantive issues exist to warrant holding a hearing.
