General Comments. A partial inspection of the surface mine was conducted with two objectives

- (1) To followup on NOV 97-26-4-1 and
- (2) To check on the condition of environmental control measures on the upper site.

Compliance. The ninety day deadline on NOV 97-26-4-1 is 9/9/97. The NOV concerns MSHA/other government authorization as mandated by the Utah Coal Rules. MSHA has approved SCA E&W slurry cells, refuse pile, and spoil pile. They have assigned MSHA identification to each item covered by the authorization.

The operator has installed the required MSHA signs.

The aforementioned violation has been terminated effective 9/8/97. A copy provided the permittee during the inspection closure.

Sediment Ponds. The operator as previously stated has not cleaned pasture nor the tipped pond. He stated weather conditions have prevented this.
