ENERGY WEST/PACIFICORP 02 COAL EXPLORATION PROJECT STATE COAL LEASE ML-48258 MANTI-LA SAL NATIONAL FOREST FERRON/PRICE RANGER DISTRICT EMERY COUNTY, UTAH

Forest Supervisor, has decided authorize Energy West/PacificCorp to Forest System lands to conduct a helicopter-assisted coal drilling July 29 to October 1, 2002. The project will consider of eight core holes in Mill Canyon, Mill Fork Canyon, and upper Joes Valley. The purpose of the project is to analyze seam characteristics and thickness. The drill holes would be located on current Utah Coal Lease ML-48258, Sections 10, 12, 13, 15, and 22 of Township 13 South, Range 10 East, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, and running thence West 80 feet; thence South 124 feet; thence East 80 feet; thence North 124 feet to the point of beginning.

Beginning at a point 623.5 feet South and 75 feet West of the Northeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 30, Township 13 South, Range 10 East, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, and running thence West 80 feet; thence South 124 feet; thence East 80 feet; thence North 124 feet to the point of beginning.

Together with all the improvements now or hereafter erected on the property, and all easements, appurtenances, and fixtures now or hereafter a part of the property.

NOTICE AND REQUEST FOR COMMENT LINK CANYON FUEL, LLC, SUFCO MINE LINK CANYON PORTAL OPENING, PERMIT AMENDMENT MANTI-LA SAL NATIONAL FOREST SEVIER COUNTY, UTAH

Link Canyon Fuel, LLC has submitted a Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP) Permit Amendment proposing to construct a pad and access road to open up the Link Canyon Mine. The Link Canyon Portal would be used for ventilation intake, escapeway in the event of an emergency, and for emergency response to the Link Canyon Mine.

The proposed Link Canyon Mine Portal Pad is described as: T.21 S., R.26 W.1/2, NW1/4, SW1/4, SLM. The Link Canyon mine is situated in about 6.5 miles north west of the town of Emery and 30 miles east of the town of Price. The proposed pad is within 100 feet of the forest rod #044.

The Forest Supervisor must decide whether or not to provide consent, and if so, what conditions must be attached to the permit for the protection of non-coal resources.

The proposed area (approximately 0.23 acres) for the Link Canyon Portal facility is within the present approved Permit area. Sediment control, reclamation, and the Link Canyon Portal would be done the same way as for other portal openings in the MRP. The Site would be reclaimed when no longer needed for the Link Canyon Mine.

You are invited on this proposal.
