

The following notice of intent to construct, submitted in accordance with Section R307-401-1, Utah Air Quality Rules, has been received for consideration by the Executive Secretary, Utah Air Quality Board:

Sunnyside Cogeneration Associates

Location: One Power Plant Road, Sunnyside, UT 84539

Project Description: Sunnyside Cogeneration Associates (SCA) operates an electric power plant near Sunnyside, Utah. The Sunnyside Plant is a waste coal-fired steam electric generating plant located in Carbon County. SCA is requesting approval to install an emergency Standby diesel generator at the SCA plant site. The generator will be used in the event of disruption of normal electrical power, and periods when the generator is operated for testing/maintenance. Carbon County is an attainment area of the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) for all pollutants. Title V of the 1990 Clean Air Act applies to this source. The Title V operating permit for this source will be amended prior to the operation of the new equipment. This public comment period is being published to evaluate the public's input on the project proposed by SCA.

The Proposed Emissions increase will be (A negative sign indicates a decrease in emission rates.):

PM <sub>10</sub>	0.04 tons/year
SO <sub>2</sub>	0.04 tons/year
NO <sub>x</sub>	0.60 tons/year
CO	0.13 tons/year
VOC	0.06 tons/year

The completed engineering evaluation and air quality impact analysis showed that no new violations of National Ambient Air Quality Standards or Prevention of Significant Deterioration Increments will occur. It is the intent of the Executive Secretary to approve the construction project.

The construction proposal and estimate of the effect on local air quality are available for public inspection and comment at the Utah Division of Air Quality, Department of Environmental Quality, 150 North 1950 West, Salt Lake City, Utah 84114-4820. Any questions may be directed to Nando Meli at (801) 536-4052 or email: nmeli@utah.gov. There will be a 30-day comment period held. Written comments received by the Division, at the same address on or before September 26, 2002, will be considered in making the final decision on the approval/disapproval of the proposed construction.

If anyone so requests to the Executive Secretary at the Division in writing, within 15 days of publication of the Notice, a hearing will be held to explain the project and technical rationale for the proposed action. The hearing will be scheduled as close as practicable to the proposed project location. Comments obtained during the hearing will be evaluated and considered by the Executive Secretary before making a final decision on the approval/disapproval of the project.
