
The Division staff have reviewed your application and found that the only information submitted is maps. No information or justification for the increase storage area has been provided. Information as to whether the amount of soil required for reclamation is sufficient and if the bond is sufficient is also lacking.

The maps show the general area, drainage locations and cross sections. General volumes are listed on the maps, but no documentation for each cross section is given for review.

This is a preliminary list of deficiencies from an initial review of the application, but do not constitute a complete list of the items needed to approve this amendment. A more detailed plan and explanation must be provided to the Division. Therefore, your application is being returned (enclosed). If you wish to proceed with this project please re-submit the application with the needed information.
