Please find enclosed three copies of SCA's permit amendment pertaining to future changes to the refuse coal processing system located within the permit boundary at the Sunnyside Facility. The changes will involve replacing the existing Primary Crusher with a new Primary Screen, replacing the existing Primary Screen with a new screen ( will be referred to as the Secondary Screen) and making some conveyor relocation changes.

The changes to the processing system will not change/increase SCA's bonding or reclamation requirements. The project will remain within the existing foot print and will not disturb any new areas. We are primarily replacing existing equipment with new or a different type of equipment. The permit amendment involves description changes to Chapter 5 text and one drawing.


