**1. Permits, Change, Transfer, Renewal, Sale**

**2. Signs and Markers**

The mine ID sign is located adjacent to the tibble on a light pole. The MSHA Refuse Pile sign was also checked during the inspection and contained the required information.

**7. Coal Mine Waste, Refuse Piles, Impoundments**

The refuse pile appeared stable, no visible hazards. The operation has started using a track hoe to excavate the material. A temporary pipe line has been run onto the permit area, refuse pile surface, for dust suppression. The Division was notified of this action and has instructed the operator that if it was to remain for more than a year it would need to go through a permit amendment.
