Notice is hereby given as required by the Utah Coal Mining Rules, R645-301-800 that Sunnyside Cogeneration Associates (SCA), P.O. Box 159, Sunnyside UT 84539, has filed an application requesting Phase 3 Bond Release for a reclaimed portion of its land. Approval of this application will allow SCA to reduce its bond for approximately 5.35 acres that were reclaimed in 1994 under the provisions of the Utah Coal Mining and Reclamation Act and the Utah R645 Coal Mining Rules. (Permit # C\007\035 Sunnyside Refuse & Slurry) SCA has a cash bond for reclamation on file in the amount of \$1.775 Million and is requesting the release of \$40,000. The reclamation work (including grading, soil cover placement and revegetation) meets all performance standards for soil cover, vegetation success and sediment control as required by the approved plan to achieve the post mining land use for wildlife and grazing.
