Based upon an initial review, it was determined that information required for bond release was missing from the application. We are returning the application based upon the following:


- **R645-301-880.120-** The public notice requires:
 - The type of bond filed with the Division.
 - The amount of the bond filed with the Division.
 - A description of the results achieved as they relate to the Operator's approved reclamation plan.
- **R645-301-880.130-** The application must include a notarized statement which certifies that all applicable reclamation activities have been accomplished in accordance with the requirements of the Act, the regulatory program, and the approved reclamation plan. Such certification shall be submitted for each application or phase of bond release.

Subsequent discussions between Division staff and Sunnyside Cogeneration representatives have identified revisions that will satisfy the requirements of the State of Utah R645-Coal Mining Rules. It was further discussed that resubmission of the Phase III bond release application will occur after the 30 day public notice period has been completed.
