Deficiencies Details:

The amendment does not meet the State of Utah R645 requirements for Sediment Control Measures. The following deficiency must be addressed prior to final approval.

R645-301-732: The amendment does not include a narrative or designs for the BTCA AREA just west of Pasture Pond. The amendment must include a narrative describing the sediment control measures that are taken in this BTCA area to capture suspended sediment and treat runoff prior to leaving the permit area. The map must include the BTCA structures described in this narrative.
