112.300-330 Information Regarding "Owners" and "Controllers":

The Applicant, SCA, is a Utah joint venture. SCA holds the contracts, property, and permits for the project in its name. Because the joint venture is essentially a partnership between Sunnyside Holdings I, Inc. ~~and Colmac Utah, Inc., and Sunnyside II, L.P.~~, SCA has no corporate information of its own. Therefore, the information required under regulation 112.300- 330 is provided for the joint venture partners, Sunnyside Holdings I, Inc. and ~~Colmac Utah, Inc. 


