The amendment identifies the lands subject to coal mining and reclamation within the permit area. The amendment will remove approximately 5.8 undisturbed acres from the permit area that have never been disturbed by mining activity. The Division has inspected the area to ensure this is the case, see inspection report #5943 for documentation. The amendment includes an update to Drawing 1-1, SCA Permit Area Legal Description. While the amendment includes a Draft Public Notice, this is not necessary because the adjustment in acreage does not fall under the category of a bond
