
Thank you for the extension of the Blackhawk Exploration Permit. We will abide by the stipulations enumerated in your letter of November 17, 1993. We have ordered the seed mix for the disturbed areas according to the approved seed mix included in the approved exploration permit. The application rate will be according to the approved rate of 21.7 lbs/Acre (hand broadcast). If snow conditions prevent us from accessing any of the sites this fall, we will seed those sites as early in the spring as possible.

We ask that we be given the opportunity to accompany the inspector when he/she inspects the site. Please call me the day before the inspection if possible; I realize the regulations do not allow advance notice, however, one days notice would not give us time to clean up any violations before the inspection anyway.

We will be starting the permitting work for the Mining And Reclamation Permit for the project about January 3, 1994. I will be calling you soon to arrange preliminary scoping meetings with your staff to discuss permit ground rules, permit organization and etc. Considering the possible restructuring of your staff, I would like to know which team will be assigned the Blackhawk permit, or what responsible person/s will be assigned the permit.
