4a. Diversions -

The diversions were damp due to the rain storm which had taken place prior to inspection. The diversions which were spot-checked had functioned as designed; some weeds were within the ditches. The operator said the weeds would be cleared out of the ditches. No breaching could be seen.

4b. Other Sediment Control Measures -

Several silt fences throughout the property were overtopped or bypassed, therefore, a Notice of Violation was issued. The damage of the area from the rain storm gave possibility that this storm exceeded the design event. The operator submitted information and calculations which supported in excess of the design event. Therefore, the violation was vacated.
