The diversions throughout the property were stable with no signs of erosion or breaching. The ditches have not had any water flowing, due to the lack of rainfall.

4b. Other Sediment Control Measures -

The catch basins at the site were dry with no signs of erosion of the embankments, inlets, or outlets.

13. Revegetation -

There are several areas where seeding will be required, the area by the creek and the road cut from the access road to the sub-station. August would be an appropriate time to have a joint inspection.
