The above-noted minor coal exploration application has been reviewed. This application for exploration of the Panther Canyon drill site is approvable conditioned upon the applicant adequately addressing the following issues prior to initiating construction activities:

1. The application needs to identify how much topsoil will be salvaged and stored. (Alternatively, the applicant may commit to have a qualified person present when the topsoil is being salvaged to determine how much topsoil needs to be saved.)
2. The application must include a standard by which erosion control, and thus revegetation success, can be judged.
3. Sediment control measures must be addressed satisfactorily pursuant to R645-301-742.100.
