Purpose:

Investigation of flow corrections to Willow Creek realignment.

Observations:

Willow Creek was flowing about 5 to 10 gallons per minute above the stream realignments. Flow was not seen on the surface shortly after it entered the upper realignment.

Recommendations/Conclusions:

NOV 96-44-1-1 was terminated because Cyprus Plateau had completed some of the measures required and other measure in the NOV were not acceptable to the Army Corp of Engineers (404 permitting agency for the stream alteration). The monitoring stations should be installed as soon as the State Engineer permits the new stream modifications (approximately 3 weeks). If flow losses continue through next summer, the need for additional work on the channel will be investigated.
