The application for bond release for the same area at the Wellington Preparation Plant under the provisions of R645-301-880 is also being sought. The type of bond is a Surety Bond with a total amount of \$4,904,000. The disturbed areas, structures and amounts to be released from the bond for reclamation accomplished in 1997-98 are given in this notice.

**NOTICE**

The following notice of intent to construct, submitted in accordance with Section R307-401-1, Utah Air Conservation Rules, has been received for consideration by the Executive Secretary, Utah Air Quality Board:

Cyprus Plateau Mining Corporation  
Location: 847 NW Hwy. 191, Helper, UT 84528  
Project Description: Reduction of the Moisture Content for Raw and Clean Coal

Cyprus Plateau Mining (Cyprus) is requesting a modification at the Willow Creek Coal Mine and Processing Plant. Cyprus has identified a need to add a crushing/screening plant at the portal of the mine. The opacity limits at the plant will remain the same. This equipment will be used to size the coal prior to traveling on the overland conveyor system which transports coal from the mine to the processing facilities. The facility is located in Carbon County. The addition of this equipment is a minor modification to a minor source located in an attainment area for all criteria pollutants. There are not changes in throughputs, product limits, fuel requirements, or operation hours. Carbon County is an attainment area of the national air quality standards for all pollutants. New Source Performance Standards (NSPS) Subpart Y (Standards of Performance for Coal Preparation Plants) apply to the proposed additional equipment. Title V applies to this source. Therefore, a 30-day public comments period is required.

This Modification will result in an increase of: PM<sup>10</sup>.....2.62 ton/year  
No increase in SO<sub>2</sub>, NO<sub>x</sub>, CO, and VOC.

The engineering evaluation and air quality impact analysis have been completed and no new violations of National Ambient Air Quality Standards or Prevention of Significant Deterioration Increments will occur. It is the intent of the Executive Secretary to approve the construction project.

The construction proposal and estimates of the effect on local air quality are available for public inspection and comment at the Division of Air Quality, Utah State Department of Environmental Quality, 150 North 1950 West, Salt Lake City, 84114-4820. There will be a 30-day comment period held. Written comments received by the Division, at the same address on or before January 28, 1999, will be considered in making the final decision on the approval/disapproval of the proposed construction.

If anyone so requests to the Executive Secretary at the Division in writing, within 15 days of publication of the Notice, a hearing will be held to explain the project and technical rationale for proposed action. A hearing will be scheduled as close as practicable to the proposed project location. Comments obtained during a hearing will be evaluated and considered by the Executive Secretary before making a final decision on the approval/disapproval of the project.
