Re: Industrial Post Mining Land Use Change, Willow Creek Mine Main Facilities Area, Plateau Mining Corporation, Willow Creek Mine, C/007/038, Carbon County, Utah

Dear Mr. Haddock:

Plateau Mining Corporation (PMC) is resubmitting its application for a change in the postmining land use to lands owned by PMC within the Willow Creek Mine Permit. The land use change will facilitate an industrial use pursuant to R645-301-413.300.

To support the industrial land use, PMC revised its reclamation plan to reflect the structures, access roads, material storage areas, runoff control and treatment structures, and other appurtenant structures necessary to support the proposed land use. The backfilling and grading plan shows the highwall eliminated for most of its extent to the degree achieved by AML.

An industrial postmining land use surface facilities map (Map 18C) was generated to aid in presenting the structures necessary to support the proposed land use. PMC is providing revised reclamation costs based on the industrial land use and taking into account the structures and facilities that will remain to support the land use.

Furthermore, the postmining topography and drainage structure maps reflect the existing approved topography along with the proposed industrial land use alternative (Maps 21A through 21D). Another new map was generated to reflect the industrial postmining reclamation treatment and watershed map (Map 21G). Numerous maps were revised or created to aid and ease the Division with their review process.

The industrial land use may take some time to be implemented, but as we all know, there is no requirement, either in SMCRA or the regulations, that postmining land uses be implemented immediately following mining. As required by regulation, bond release to that proposed under the industrial land use scenario can not be applied for and approved until the land use is achieved. Therefore, the approved full reclamation scenario and bond remain in effect, until otherwise approved for reduction.


