1. Permits, Change, Transfer, Renewal, Sale

An application for phase one bond release for the Schoolhouse refuse pile and an application for phase three bond release for the remaining buildings and associated property was hand-delivered to the Division on September 23, 2005 by the undersigned. The review was due on November 30, 2005. The technical analysis should be completed and sent to the operator during the week of December 5th.

2. Signs and Markers

Signs containing the required information were posted at the entrances to the reclaimed areas.

3. Topsoil

The disturbed area associated with the loadout facility is slated for reclamation this year pending weather conditions. If the soil is not frozen, the area will be roughened and seeded.

18. Support Facilities, Utility Installations

The dismantling of the loadout is near completion, several weeks. At that time, the area will be reclaimed, weather and soil conditions permitting.
