Concerning the mission samples:

I input the Willow Creek pond and outfall UTG040012-001 data for July, August and September in December on the same day I input the other samples; I must have made some type of mistake. You might remember that you were walking me through the input and upload by phone. I assumed if something did not happen correctly I would have received some type of computer message. My lack of experience is the issue here. The DMR's for the quarter indicate there were no discharges from this pond therefore there were no samples. I recall at the time I input the data, that without a discharge, I could not determine a sample date, therefore, I input the last day of the month for each sample. Please give me a call once you have received this message and hopefully we can determine what I did wrong.

The problem with Star Point 971 is that I thought this was a quarterly sample/input; I thought the ponds and outfalls (DMR reports) were the only monthly reportable samples. Unfortunately, Johnny's departure from our company was so sudden that there was very little time for my training. I seen Johnny Pappas' field notes from his quarterly water sampling on this site for the month of September but did not see any data as to any site visits in July and August. I will contact Johnny to see if he has field notes on having visited the site in July and August Again I apologize and hope the division will take the circumstances into consideration.
