Dennis Ware believes he will be done pumping the good water from the #2 shaft sometime Monday, April 23, 2003. Approximately 120 feet of water depth consists of crappy water which at this point would never meet effluent parameters at discharge.

Dennis says he has contacted someone in SL City who says they have a sea shell product which can quickly and effectively settle out the suspended solids. He will forward the MSDS sheet for this product to all agencies ASAP. Dennis would like a quick approval to use this product. The pump rental is \$900 per day, and he obviously wants to complete all the dewatering he can ASAP, so the pump can be returned. The amount of product to settle out the SS in the remaining water, (after Monday), will cost about \$10,000.

Water Quality is, I believe, still the lead here, but as the DOGM is the SMCRA regulatory agency, we should certainly be involved. I suppose my biggest concern is that the product to be used would be biologically safe to discharge to the Price River.
