Based on your comments I will prepare the "Bonded Area Legal Description" to include only the land that has been disturbed less the lands that have received phase III bond release (the PRWID and CEU lands). Since Barn Canyon was never disturbed the Barn Canyon land will also be removed from the description.

Dennis,

The bonded area for the Willow Creek Mine is currently the same as the disturbed area. Therefore, any changes to the bonded area are changes to the disturbed area. In the case of the Barn Canyon Shaft, the disturbed area decreased because you are no longer allowed to disturb that area.

You mentioned that you have turned back several federal coal leases. The permit area still covers those areas even if you no longer have a coal lease on them. One suggestion is to reduce the permit area so that the permit area is about the same as the disturbed area.

I hope this helps. Call me if you have questions.

We are in the process of preparing the documents you sent to me for bond release for the Barn Canyon Shaft which was never constructed. One question has come up related to Exhibit A. This question is what is the meaning of "Bonded Area Legal Description" (not defined in the Coal Rules R645)? Since the Willow Creek Mine has been fully reclaimed and the coal leases have been turned back to the BLM I assume the Bonded Area Legal Description is the area which was disturbed and reclaimed but has not received Phase III bond release rather than the "Permit Area" which is defined in the Coal Rules (R645).

This question was posed to Wayne Western who ask me to go to you for the answer.
