THIS WARRANTY IS IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, AN FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. THERE ARE NO WARRANTIES WHICH EXTEND BEYOND THE DESCRIPTION ON THE LABEL.

No claim shall be asserted against the labeled seller unless Buyer reports to the labeled seller within a reasonable period (not to exceed thirty days), any condition that might lead to a complaint. Buyer shall return the original unopened seed package to the labeled seller within twenty days of receipt for a refund of the purchase price if not accepted under these terms.

NOTICE: REQUIRED ARBITRATION / CONCILIATION / MEDIATION

The seed laws of several states including Arkansas, California, Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Minnesota, Missouri, Montana, North Dakota, South Carolina, South Dakota, Texas and Washington require arbitration, conciliation or mediation of disputes involving alleged defective seed before certain legal actions may be maintained against a seller. North Carolina offers an alternative to court action that allows claimant to file the stipulated and labeled Seed Complaint with the Department of Agriculture or Seed Commissioner (SD) or State Plant Board (AR). GA, ID, ND, SD) must be filed with the Department of Agriculture or Seed Commissioner (SD) or State Plant Board (AR). Commitment to Arbitration (AC) with rules to govern an arbitration of seed, crops or plants. (By an Arbitration Committee - AR, ID, MS, SC). In NC, the rules to govern an arbitration of seed, crops or plants are recoverable. Copy of complaint must be sent by registered mail to the labeled seller as provided in individual state law.
