The nearest potential canyon habitat is about a mile to the northeast, but not in the sections you requested. Until we get further clarification beyond Laura's guidance last week, here's what we have on its use. Again, you need to ground truth the prediction to see if there's really steep slope mixed conifer before you assume you'll have to survey for one year.
