The Resource Development Coordinating Committee (RDCC), representing the State of Utah, has reviewed this proposal. The Division of Wildlife Resources comments:

No map or UTM coordinates were provided with the project proposal, but most of this area is critical summer range for elk and/or mule deer. We are concerned that if this project occurs during spring or early summer, traffic, construction of pads, and drilling could negatively impact the rearing of young elk and mule deer. We therefore request that all activity involving heavy equipment be delayed until after July 5th each summer.
