We have completed our technical review of the As-Built Drainage Control amendment for the Dugout Canyon Mine facility. Division approval of this amendment will become effective upon our receipt of a transmittal letter, C1/C2 form and five (5) clean copies of this application. Upon our receipt of these clean records, a stamped incorporated copy will be returned to you for your mine plan records.

The Division reviewed the submitted as-built drawings and text revisions. In addition, Division personnel field verified the drainage control system on August 1st, 2006. The drainage system appeared to be functioning as designed during the field visit. No significant impacts to hydrologic resources were noted at the time of the inspection.

Because this action is considered a minor change to the approved Mining and Reclamation Plan, no updates to the Technical Analysis are necessary at this time.



OPERATIONAL WATERSHED BOUNDARY




DISTURBED AREA BOUNDARY
