As part of the conditional approval for the construction and operation of Degas Wells G-18, G-31 and the AMV road at the Dugout Canyon Mine Facility (Task ID #2846), the Permittee was required to submit as-built drawings of various elements of the project within 30 days of construction. On November 21, 2007 the Division received two drawings depicting: an as-built profile of the AMV road, cross sections of the topsoil stockpiles associated with the AMV road, as well as selected cross-sections of the AMV road itself. This letter acknowledges the 30-day commitment to supply the drawings to the Division (as requested) has been met.

A deficiency has been identified relative to the submitted drawings. In order for the Division staff to accurately inspect/review the submitted as-built drawings with the constructed features in the field, an index map showing the locations of the surveyed soil stockpiles and road cross sections must be provided to the Division.

Due to weather conditions, it is not possible at this time for Division staff to physically inspect the construction. As a result, the Permittee will need to re-submit the as-built drawings with an index map by May 1, 2008.
