Sorry I forgot to put you on the original email that I sent yesterday night. Instead I have forwarded it. This is for your information.

Vicki,

Thank you for the notification last Thursday and the other calls since then. We know that high iron is not a common occurrence at this mine, and that it was the result of eliminating a mine fire. I am sending this message to you to remind you that this is a significant noncompliance and that if the mine has two of these in a six month period we will be required to initiate an enforcement action. In short if you have another violation that is 1.4 times you permit limit or greater within the next six months we will initiate an enforcement action. If you have any violation of the permit limit (over 1.1 mg/L but under 1.4 times the permit limit) four more times within the next six months, this would also trigger an enforcement action. We are hopeful that none of this will occur in the next six months. Also, we would like to know what Dugout plans on doing in mitigating this incident. If you have any questions please contact me and I can explain further.
