2. Signs and Markers

The permit sign is located at the gate to the property. Information meets the minimum requirements of the R645 Coal Rules.

3. Topsoil

The topsoil pile are not snow covered. There was no signs of wind or water erosion to the topsoil piles.

4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions

The permittee has cleaned out several diversion, but several other will need cleaned out in the near future. The diversions are still functioning as designed.

4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments

The sediment pond did contained water but was not discharging. It is not likely to discharge in the near future. Permittee did remove some sediment from the pond last month.

7. Coal Mine Waste, Refuse Piles, Impoundments

The refuse pile was inspected and I did not see any hazardous conditions. The road within the refuse pile areas did have dust coming off when trucks drove on the road. It also had dust coming of the road when the wind blew. The permittee needs to water the road to reduce the dust.

8. Noncoal Waste

The mine site was clear of non-coal waste materials.

10. Slides and Other Damage

No slides or other damage was noticed during the inspection.

Subsidence information was in the annual report.

18. Support Facilities, Utility Installations

No new facilities were constructed since the last inspection.
