2. Signs and Markers

Checked the identification signs at the waste rock entrance and main entrance into the mine site. Both of these signs contained the operators name, address, phone number and permit number. These items are requirements that must be met. The signs are in compliance with the coal rules.

4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions

The main diversion at the waste rock site entrance has been re-constructed with geo fabric and rip rap. Other diversions at the waste rock site have been graded and cleared of soil and debris.

4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments

The main sediment pond contained water at the time of the inspection. The embankments appeared stable.

5. Explosives

The powder and cap magazines and storage area were checked during the partial inspection. The magazines are separated, signed and grounded in accordance with the regulations.

7. Coal Mine Waste, Refuse Piles, Impoundments

The refuse pile was not actively receiving material at the time of the inspection. The gate at the waste rock site was locked and secured. The refuse pile surface and slopes were graded. A safety berm is around the perimeter of the top of the pile and access roads on elevated portions of the road have a safety berm as required by MSHA. The pile appeared stable. No visible hazards.


