Dear Ms. Littig:

WEST RIDGE Resources received an NOV on February 19, 2002 which related to as-constructed surface facilities versus approved MRP surface facilities, specifically lining of ditches. The remedial action required by the NOV is essentially to line various ditches at the site. It has become necessary to respectfully request an extension of time to perform the remedial action.

The unusual aspect of this request is that WEST RIDGE Resources has determined that by making minor changes in the approved MRP, changes which have been reviewed and approved by a Registered Professional Engineer, the remedial action stipulated in the NOV will not be required. WEST RIDGE has prepared a submittal containing the information necessary to demonstrate this and will be making this submittal to the Division within the next week.

Therefore, although WEST RIDGE needs an extension on the time to comply with the specific requirements of the NOV and avoid a "failure to abate" situation, it is not anticipated that the remedial action outlined in the NOV will need to be performed.
