Here is the scoop on those 4 sites, regarding 4th quarter oil and grease:

ST-6 and ST-9: No oil and grease was analyzed 4th quarter due to an error with the bottles. I made a note of this in the comment section of the electronic submittal, and corresponded with Dana about it. I will attach our email correspondence to this email. (You would, though, have 3 other oil and grease records for ST-6 for 4th quarter because it is the site right below your UPDES point.)

ST-10: There is an oil and grease record for this site for fourth quarter on the hard-copy lab sheet. I guess for some reason CTE didn't get it listed in the electronic file, and I didn't catch that it was missing.

S-80: This is a spring site. West Ridge monitoring at springs does not require oil & grease, only the surface water sites require it.
