I have received copies of two reports for the West Ridge Mine in Carbon County (T14S, R13E, Sec. 3). The first report is titled "An Intensive Cultural Resource Survey and Inventory of the Proposed Portal, Powerline and Access Corridor in the Left Fork of the Bear Creek Canyon Area," with a project number of U-08-SC-0737b,s. The second report is titled "An Intensive Cultural Resource Survey and Inventory of the Block Area for the Proposed Gob Vent Hole in the Right Fork of the Bear Creek Canyon Area," with a project number of U-08-SC-0871s. Neither survey recorded any sites, so the projects can be considered cleared.

I'm not sure, but I believe this info needs to be passed on to DOGM (they are the ones that deal with coal permits, right?), but I don't know who over there. All I know is that I was asked to rush the arch review because MSHA has given the mine a very short window for the gob vent hole. Hopefully, you know where it needs to go from here, 'cause I don't.
