1. Permits, Change, Transfer, Renewal, Sale

The Notice of Violation #10033 has been extended for 90 days to clean the creek of coal fines. This extension was due to weather. Catch basin within the stream was inspected. The permittee is retro-fitting Catching basin A to improve sediment (coal fines) cleaning.

4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions

The permittee was in the process of issuing a PO to a contractor in cleaning out the diversions at the mine site. Several of the diversions have sediment build-up.

4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments

The sediment pond was inspected with no hazardous condition noticed during the inspection. The pond did contain a small amount of water but was not discharging.

7. Coal Mine Waste, Refuse Piles, Impoundments

This mine site does not have coal mine waste piles.

8. Noncoal Waste

The mine site was recently cleaned up of non-coal waste materials.

10. Slides and Other Damage

No slides or damages were noticed during the inspection.

16.b Roads: Drainage Controls

Diversions along the road are planed to be clean out. Sediment has started to fill some of the diversions.

18. Support Facilities, Utility Installations

There was no new construction of support facilities since the last inspection.
