Daron....I would like to request an extension of time to respond to Task 3077 (attached). The items are as follows:

- 1) County road.....It was just recently that we received the SITLA easement for the road. This took longer than we thought for processing through SITLA, and we are now working with the county to make the formal assignment to them. (The original application to SITLA specifically referred to the fact that the road easement would be assigned over to the county). We need additional time to complete the formalities of the transfer.
- 2) Lab results.... Bob Long has the analysis results back from the lab for the topsoil, and has assured me that he will PDF a copy sometime today. I will forward these on to the Division as soon as I receive them, hopefully today or tomorrow.
- 3) Exhibit A of reclamation agreement....Paul Picolini, who handles all the bonding and insurance for the company out of the Ohio head office, told me yesterday that he should have the signed Exhibit A (legal description of the bonded area) back from the bonding company later this week. This was an old bond left over from the original company before Murray took over and there has been confusion in tracking down the right people to get the signatures. He now feels he is on the right track, and i will forward the new Exhibit A on to you just as soon as I receive it, hopefully later this week or early next week.
