Bond Increase Required

Pursuant to the decision dated February 19, 2010, received on February 24, 2010, UtahAmerican Energy, Inc. was notified that pursuant to the regulations at 43 CFR 3474.2 that the existing \$8,000 lease bond for coal lease SL-066490 was required to be increased by \$112,000 for a total of \$120,000.

This bond amount may be provided by increasing the present bond by \$112,000, by submitting an additional new bond in the amount of \$112,000 or by submitting an entirely new bond for the whole bond amount of \$120,000.

No action has been taken within the thirty day timeframe stated in which to provide this lease bond.

This notice is to inform you that

- 1) No mining of coal on this lease may proceed until a coal lease bond in the amount stated above is **approved** by this office.
- 2) Notification that it takes approximately 10 working days once the required bonding documents are received for this office to grant approval of the coal lease bond.
- 3) If any mining of the coal on this lease is attempted prior to lease bond approval, a Notice of Non Compliance will be issued immediately and any mining operation must cease.
